On behalf of the **National Water Sport Centre, British Canoe Union and Sport England**, we would like to remind you all of the basic precautions and rules that should be observed by **ALL** competitors and officials.

1. All persons on the water in canoes and motor boats **must** be able to swim at least 50 metres.
2. All craft must have integral buoyancy and be water-worthy.
3. Those on the water should be suitably dressed for the conditions prevailing at the time of the event. There may be times when this includes the wearing of buoyancy aids so please bring them with you.
4. The craft circulation rules shown in the programme should be adhered to at all times.
5. Team Leaders are responsible for ensuring that paddlers entered for events are competent to handle the prevailing conditions and can manoeuvre their craft. All paddlers must have been taught what to do in the event of capsize.
6. All competitors are advised to shower after using the Regatta Course. All cuts and abrasions should be covered with waterproof plaster. Please read the NWSC guide to water related illness, available from the Reception desk.

BCU Regatta "Liability" Statement

Canoeing and Kayaking are assumed-risk water-contact sports. Participation in these sports carries an inherent risk of injury to competitors and damage to property. Participants should be aware of the risks involved in these sports and are responsible for their own actions and their involvement in these sports.

In all cases competitors compete entirely at their own risks.

Each of the Regatta Organisation, the Sprint Racing Executive, the British Canoe Union exclude liability for any loss or damage that may occur to competitors or property during participation in canoeing and kayaking to the fullest extent permitted by law.

All competitors must be **current** comprehensive members of the British Canoe Union expert for juniors ranked in 'Girls D' or 'Boys D' who are members of clubs with registered juniors sections.

Regatta Entries are accepted on the basis that each competitor and Parent/Guardian of a junior is aware of and has accepted the above conditions. Team Leaders are requested to ensure that all of their club competitors are aware of and accept the above statements. **Particular attention is drawn to safety requirements**, especially the need for adequate buoyancy in all boats.

Sufficient fixed buoyancy must be securely fitted to all boats they are allowed on the water. Severe penalty points (and disqualification) will be incurred by all those ignoring this requirement. This is intended to ensure the safety of all those on the water.

System for membership for Juniors of a **BCU Affiliated Club**. A junior club member need not be a full member of the BCU in order to race in Junior D & Lightning Classes. He or she must be a member of his or her club, and the number used for his or her identification will be the club's affiliation number followed by his or her own individual club number. Should he or she be promoted however, to 'C or above, he or she must then become a full member of the BCU in his or her own right.

It is the responsibility of the Team Leader to advise the Registration Officer of the full BCU Number.



BCU Regatta Course Safety Instructions & Information for all Competitors and Umpires

The BCU Sprint Racing runs under BCU Sprint Racing Competition Rules & the NWSC Safety Code for canoeing.

The regatta will endeavour to provide a safe environment within the Water Safety Code although competitors and coaches are specifically reminded that persons using the lake and the adjoining river do so entirely at their own risk and are solely responsible for:

- Their own safety.
- Ensuring that their boats are safe and are prepared to the standards required by the BCU Water Safety Code and the national rules of Racing. Any boat that fails to meet the standard shall be excluded.
- Strict observance of the circulation pattern (see below) and the Water Safety Code.
- Deciding, together with their coaches, whether or not they are competent to use the lake in the prevailing weather conditions.

Clubs and competitors are also reminded that they must: -

- Only practice while safety boat on the course.
- Not practice in the race area.
- Make their own safety arrangements before and after the day's racing.
- Canoes that wish to train on the River must make their own safety arrangements. They must also ensure their boat is licensed to be on the River and follow the rules of the river.
- Ensure that all roadways and access routes are kept clear at all times and that they should not park in the Finish/Presentation Stage area. Paddlers should be especially vigilant in the boating/boathouse areas.
- Report all accidents to the Regatta Office.
- Paddlers must display the correct Lane Number.
- Paddlers must wear the correct racing vest/top.
- All paddlers must paddle to the start line **SLOWLY** down next to **Lane 1** to the Starting Line and be very careful, and clear the finish area and lake quickly and safely; you may NOT warm-down in this area.
- Results and Draws will be published inside the main building at the bottom of the stairs by NWCS reception.

Failure to comply with these rules may lead to the removal of the paddlers or club from the Event.

Points of Danger

- Great care should be taken when using the starting boats. Note that the pontoon nearest the Finish Tower is only for Umpires and Safety Boats.
- Paddlers must be aware of the potential danger of being blown by the crosswind and capsizes. Paddlers are advised to stop close to the bank.
- Paddlers must take particular care of the stake-boat mooring cables beside the start lines.
- Paddlers must particular care while on the lake.
- Paddlers must take particular care in the finish area to avoid collisions with other canoes that have just finished, have been warming down or that are returning from the presentation area.

Warming on Course Lake:

Please ensure that none of your paddlers uses the lake at all until effective safety cover is in operation by the motorboat team. The regulations mean that no paddling is permitted without appropriate safety boats. We plan to have this in place from 08:00 hours on Saturday. On Sunday cover should commence from 30 minutes prior to the first race until the end of the last race. Please ensure that all competitors are aware of the new rule.

Speed to not the start points:

All boats to proceed slowly alongside Lane 1 going down the course and past the Start Line point. And to arrive past the line of Blue Buoys (100 metres above each start line) 5 minutes before "RACE TIME". Listen for race number to be called. Remember race time is shown on the TOD Clock. If a paddler misses its slot, may not be allowed to race.

Start:

All boats shall proceed to the start SLOWLY alongside Lane 1, down the course and past the Start Line point. There have been some changes to the BCU for the start, as follows:-

"Competitors shall be on the water at the starting area not less than five minutes prior to the specified time of their race. The starting area is defined as being the area of water within 100 metres before the starting line. Two minutes before the defined starting time the competing boats have to take the lane determined in the programme"

In essence this means be at the start in good time, do not paddle too far away, stay within reach of the blue buoys (100 metre line), and get yourself lined up behind the correct lane. Listen for your race number to be called and remember that Regatta Time is shown on the TOD Clock (on the bank next to the start hut). If a paddler misses their start slot they may not be allowed to race. THE STARTERS WILL NOT WAIT.

Boat Control:

This will continue on a random basis at all BCD National Canoe Sprint racing regattas events will, in addition, be subject to the usual weighing of the first few boats in all finals.

Warming down on Course Lake:

All paddlers may warm down by carefully turning below the Finish Line and proceed back to the start line **SLOWLY** down next to **Lane 1**.

Safety Boats:

There are safety boats on the course during racing and the first duty of the umpire and the umpire's launch is to safety of the competitor or any person in difficulty.

Cycling, Skating, Rollerblading:

Cycling, skating, rollerblading etc, is prohibited in all Regatta enclosures in the main boating areas and down the side of Lane one. Cyclists etc, must give way, **at all times and towpath code for cyclists**, to pedestrians and service vehicles of the Regatta and display hazard lights.

General Information:

Trade Stands- Duty Manager [NWSC] to collect charges and issue a VAT receipt.

Anyone found camping in tents, motor homes, caravans or vans anywhere other than the campsite WILL BE REMOVED. Note this is due to the camping licence only including the campsite and ski tow camping area.

They are in breach of the licence if they allow camping on the main centre site. Please can you pass this information to all competitions and officials.

Accidents and Emergencies:

All accidents and emergencies must be reported to a Regatta Official as soon as is practicable. The Official will summon medical support if necessary and will summon any additional support that may be required. The Official will also ensure that the Regatta Organiser / Chief Official and Main Reception Centre are aware of the incident. A written Incident Report MUST be completed by the Team Leader of the appropriate club(s) for all accidents, collisions or capsizes.

Medial Support:

The Main Reception can be contacted Reception Office ☎ 0115 982 1212, next to Boathouse/Regatta Secretary Desk or any Regatta Official radio during racing. A Duty Officer of the NWSC is on call during racing day, contactable through the Centre Reception.

During racing hours will provide medical and first aid facilities at the Main Building. Medical facilities are indented to cover emergencies only.

Towpath Code for Cyclists

The National Water Sports Centre allows cyclists to use the towpath on both sides of the regatta course when weather conditions permit and at their own risk. Cycling can be hazardous so watch out for pedestrians, service vehicles, muddy slopes etc and please be sure to follow the NWSC Code.

1. Do not ride fast and never race along this towpath
2. Take special care if dogs or other animals are present
3. Track surfaces may be uneven or wet, so watch out for holes, bumps and muddy or slippery patches
4. Ride in single file and not in more than groups of four
5. Always be prepared to stop, dismount and push your bicycle past walkers, particularly when families and young children are present
6. Your bicycle must be fitted with a bell or hooters which you should use to alert other people of your approach, particularly if approaching from behind
7. Always slow down when approaching walkers or anglers. If the path is narrow, it is safer to everyone if you dismount and wheel your cycle past
8. Cyclists etc, must give way, **at all times**, to pedestrians and service vehicles
9. Minimise path erosion by not skidding. Always keep to the path – never cycle on the verge
10. Be especially careful when returning to public roads
11. Check at access points and as you continue whether the path condition is safe and not wet and muddy
12. The towpath is not suitable for organised cycling events (e.g. sponsored rides) but permission might be granted in some cases. Consult the NWSC Office
13. Cyclists are strongly advised to wear an approved safety helmet. Other safety clothing, eg knee / elbow protectors and gloves is also recommended.
14. Follow the cycle code

You are responsible for your own safety!



Duty of Care – ADEQUATE BUOYANCY and SAFETY at NATIONAL REGATTAS

Team Leaders and paddlers are reminded that, should the weather conditions on the Course Lake prove inclement, it may become necessary to introduce the *mandatory wearing* of Buoyancy Aids/Life Jackets for some or all paddlers.

In such circumstances competitors will not be allowed to go afloat without Life Jackets/Buoyancy Aids that conform to BCU/BCMA STANDARD BA83.

Furthermore the BCU Racing Rules for Regattas require that all kayaks and canoes must have fitted with adequate buoyancy in each craft as in the BCU Racing Handbook.

Team Leaders should ensure that paddlers always bring Buoyancy Aids/Life Jackets and have the correct buoyancy fitted to their boats. Safety rules in the BCU Racing Handbook:-

“that all canoes are fitted with buoyancy, sufficient to ensure that the canoe will remain afloat and support the crew in the event of a capsize.”

“buoyancy will be checked by both systematic and random inspection at launching point. If a boat is found to have insufficient buoyancy, it will be turned back”.

“particular attention is drawn to safety requirements, especially the need for adequate buoyancy in all boats. Sufficient fixed buoyancy must be securely fitted to all boats before they are allowed on the water.”

What to do if anyone takes the swim (capsizes) and you think you may have an infection – go to your doctor and tell him/her that there may be a risk of Weil's Disease/Leptospirosis that must be swiftly diagnosed and treated. Please report any cases of these two to the BCU Office. ☎ 0845 370 9500



EVERYONE CAN HELP & WANTED Once again it is time to appeal to the clubs for more assistance in the running of the national competitions. A few people do most of the work prior to the event, but more pairs of hands are needed on the course whilst events are in progress. Please encourage members of your club to offer their help. If you are one of the bigger clubs it would seem fair that more helpers should be forthcoming from you. Please, even if you can only do a few hours each time, that would be a very big help, because without it the programme may be curtailed. My team is always looking for new members and we've introduced a “Buddy” system. So come forward and offer to help – don't complain, help to change.



GUIDELINES FOR USE OF PHOTOGRAPHIC & FILMING EQUIPMENT

Whilst the BCU recognises that publicity and pictures/ recordings of young people enjoying Paddlesport are essential to promote the sport and a healthy lifestyle, the following guidelines should be observed.

The key concerns regarding the use of images of children and young people relate to:

- The possible identification of children when a photograph is accompanied by personal information.
- The inappropriate use, adaptation or copying of images for use on child pornography or illegal website.
- The taking of inappropriate photographs or recorded images of children.

Guidelines for Photographic/ Recorded Images

- Ensure parents/ guardian/ young person have granted their consent for the taking and publication of photographic images.
- All children featured in recordings must be appropriately dressed with outer clothing garments covering torso from at least the bottom of their neck to their thighs (i.e. a minimum of vest/ shirt and shorts).
- The photograph or recording should focus on the activity rather than a particular young person and personal details, which might make the young person vulnerable, such as their exact address, should not be revealed.
- Clubs, coaches and volunteers should be allowed to use video equipment as a legitimate coaching aid and means of recording special occasions however care should be taken in the dissemination and storage of the material.
- You should not use any images of a child or young persons who is the subject of any court order or who has denied you their consent.
- Parents and spectators taking photographs/ recordings should be prepared to identify themselves if requested and state their purpose for photography/ filming.
- Any instances of the use if inappropriate images should be reported to the Club, BCU or the Police.

Guidelines for Publishing Photographic/ Recorded Images

- If a photograph is used, avoid naming the child by using their first name only. Personal details of children such as an email address, home address and telephone numbers should never be revealed on a website or in print.
- Think about the level of consideration that you give to the use of images in all publications, for example the process used in choosing photographs for a publicity brochure for the club. Apply an increased level of consideration to the images of children used on websites.

My fellow Team Leaders, welcome to the first BCU Open National & Class Championship event all races are 'Open' and medals will be awarded to the first three boats regardless of nationality. The National or Class Champion will be the best placed British paddler. With this event moved to September has produced larger entry than usual. We have had to trim the number of races but still pretty excessive 307, which means we will not finish on Saturday until 6.40pm and Sunday will run from 8am. I hope your team has a very enjoyable and successful two days. Over the course of the weekend we have 307 races and, as in previous years, in order to keep the size of the regatta within reasonable bounds not all paddlers will get through to a final. Please check your programme to see how this may affect you this weekend - everything is marked on the programme.

Advance Notice about K1 200m racing has to take place first thing on Sunday morning starting at 8am, please check with program timetable. We believe in putting the competitors' needs at the top of our agenda. Over the course of the weekend we have many more races than last year but there are still plenty to get through over the course of the weekend. So, please help us to help you by getting to the start in plenty of time, paying attention to the starters and coming to Boat Control (if called) as quickly as possible. I would like to congratulate all those paddlers who were promoted at the July event. Certificates for promoted junior paddlers will be presented by SRC Chairman, Peter Moule and myself, on Sunday at 1pm at the bottom of the tower area. Please make sure all your paddlers attend.

"Our challenge is to successfully manage both the requirements of canoe sprint racing and the long term regeneration of canoe sprint racing. Achieving both of these will bring fantastic opportunities for the whole of the UK."

Team Leaders [B13] - Each club must nominate one representative to deal with alterations and late entries at the meeting. This nominated representative will be responsible for all the money owed for the entries he submits. This money must be paid by 4:00pm on Saturday. Failure to pay on time will incur a £20.00 surcharge that must be paid by the end of racing on Saturday. Failure to meet this deadline will result in all paddlers from that club being disqualified from Sunday's racing.

A copy of the circulation plan can be found in the printed programme.

Towpath Code for Cyclists - The National Water Sport Centre allows cyclists to use the towpath on sides of the regatta course when weather conditions permit and at their own risk. Cycling can be hazardous so watch out for pedestrians, service vehicles, muddy slopes etc and please be sure to follow the NWSC Code. Your attention to the program. You are responsible for your own safety!

Boat Control - Weighing

The Boat Control tent has been moved to the other side of the Finish Tower and this operation will continue on a random basis for the coming season. To assist with the task of informing the paddlers, in conjunction with commentary, we will now be using a Number board display showing Lane numbers called for boat weighing.

Parking of cars - There will be no parking of any vehicle on the beachside overlooking the regatta lake starting from the Tower all the way down to metal gate near the 200m start huts. Would all vehicle users please park in a manner which is respectful of other visitors to the National Water Sports Centre. This means allowing adequate access for emergency vehicles and for the unloading / loading of boats. In particular I would ask motorists who use the area at the bottom end of the course next to the boatsheds to be particularly aware of the needs of the Paddleability paddlers. It is important to allow for additional items such as wheelchairs and for greater than average space to access the water. Please do not park on the pontoons and make sure there is plenty of space around them.

Late entries - Just a reminder: late entries for ALL laned events must be made at the Team Leaders' Meeting. Entries will NOT be accepted at the Regatta Secretary's Desk once the TL Meeting has closed, (as per the Racing Handbook, section under the BCU Canoe Sprint Racing Rules 2009).

Qualification for all finals - All draws for finals will be based on TIMES from the heats with the exception of Mens A, Woman's A, Boys A & Girls A where qualification is based on place.

Cancellation, Fees - Just a reminder: In the event of cancellation of part of or the whole of the competition owing to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances there will be no refund of race fees.

Mini K4, Mini K2 & Lightning events - Aims to encourage the development of skills and participants in sprint racing, thereby laying long-term foundations for the future of sport of canoe racing. This event is to encourage the participants to train, improve and to compete together.

Number Boards - A plea! Please help us and your club paddlers by making sure that all boats carry a number in all races. Sadly quite a number failed to do so at the last regatta. Not only does this make it very difficult for officials at the finish but penalty points will have been incurred.

Wooden Shields - For sale New wooden boards have been made for the **Tiddly Winks** awarded to junior paddlers who come in the first three places in Final 1 only. The buttons can be fixed to the boards making a display. These are available from the Regatta Secretary's Desk at a cost of £5.00 each.

Lane Number Boards FOR SALE - Sprint racing lane number boards (1 to 9) are available from the Regatta Secretary's Desk **£15**.

AS EVER THE STARTERS UNDER STRICT INSTRUCTIONS TO START RACES ON TIME and not to wait for late arrivals. Please ensure that all your paddlers are ready to start their races **ON TIME**. Please also make paddlers aware that at the end of each race they might be called for Boat Weighing (if called) as quickly as possible. They must come directly to Boat Control before warming-down **OR THEY RUN THE RISK OF DISQUALIFICATION**. So let's all be positive and look forward to a rewarding and uplifting weekend.

BCU Regatta "Liability" Statement Canoeing and Kayaking are assumed-risk water-contact sports. Participation in these sports carries an inherent risk of injury to competitors and damage to property. Participants should be aware of the risks involved in these sports and are responsible for their own actions and their involvement in these sports. In all cases competitors compete entirely at their own risks. Each of the Regatta Organisation, the Sprint Racing Executive, the British Canoe Union exclude liability for any loss or damage that may occur to competitors or property during participation in canoeing and kayaking to the fullest extent permitted by law.

All competitors must be **current** comprehensive members of the British Canoe Union expert for juniors ranked in 'Girls D' or 'Boys D' who are members of clubs with registered juniors sections.

Regatta Entries are accepted on the basis that each competitor and Parent/Guardian of a junior is aware of and has accepted the above conditions. Team Leaders are requested to ensure that all of their club competitors are aware of and accept the above statements. **Particular attention is drawn to safety requirements**, especially the need for adequate buoyancy in all boats.

Sufficient fixed buoyancy must be securely fitted to all boats they are allowed on the water. Severe penalty points (and disqualification) will be incurred by all those ignoring this requirement. This is intended to ensure the safety of all those on the water.

NWCS regulations mean that no paddling is permitted without appropriate safety boats. We plan to have this in place from 08:00 hours on Saturday. On Sunday cover should commence from 30 minutes prior to the first race until the end of the last long distance race. Please ensure that all competitors are aware of the new rule.

Community Crime Prevention Security Notice:- We would like to remind everyone of security procedures: * **Do not leave your belongings unattended.** * **Do not leave your vehicle unlocked.** If you see anyone acting suspiciously, please report this immediately to Reception ☎ 0115 982 1212 or any member of Centre staff.



Profiles for Commentary - Are you able to assist us by providing some background information about your paddlers? If you're happy for such information to be used as part of the race commentary then please forward this to the regatta organiser.

BCU System for membership for Juniors of a BCU Affiliated Club. A junior club member need not be a full member of the BCU in order to race in Junior D Classes. He or she must be a member of his or her club, and the number used for his or her identification will be the club's affiliation number followed by his or her own individual club number.

Should he or she be promoted however, to 'C' or above, he or she must then become a full member of the BCU in his or her own right.

It is the responsibility of the Team Leader to advise the Registration Officer of the full BCU Number. Upon promotion to "C" Class there is a period of grace of **4 weeks** during which a junior, racing with a registered junior section card, must become an individual comprehensive member of the BCU/WCA/SCA/CANI.

World Class Programme Profiling



The World Class Programme will use the April and September National Regattas annually to profile squad and non-programme athlete's performance.

The National Performance Coach (NPC) will develop a ranking and % of GMT from these regattas. This will be used by the NPC and the section Coach to evaluate if a non programme athlete will be invited to join the Canoe England Senior Sprint Squad* and train with the World Class Programme athletes.

To be considered for the Canoe England Senior Sprint Squad, athletes will need to race in the following the events:

- K1/C1 200m
- K1/C1 500m
- K1/C1 1000m

After evaluating the athletes ranking across the three events, a % of GMT will be developed to determine an athlete's standard within the current U23 Development programme athletes. Before recommending an athlete's inclusion in the Canoe England Senior Sprint Squad the coaches will assess the athlete's:

- Commitment to completing an agreed amount of training with programme coaches within the Bisham High Performance Training Centre or the Nottingham High Performance Training Centre or other suitable locations chosen by the programme coaches.
- A Profile of improving performance in physiological, technical and mental capacities
- Age profile
- Training background and history.

***Canoe England Senior Sprint Squad**

To assist the development and transition of athletes from club level to achieving international results, and therefore programme funding, the World Class Programme will develop a 'Canoe England Senior Sprint Squad'.

These athletes will be included in the training squad with a primary objective of assisting the performance through exposure to World Class coaching and a training environment.

The athletes will be eligible for Coaching, Facility access and use of programme equipment when available.

All boats shall proceed to the start SLOWLY alongside Lane 1, down the course and past the Start Line point. There have been some changes to the ICF for the start, as follows:-

"Competitors shall be on the water at the starting area not less than five minutes prior to the specified time of their race. The starting area is defined as being the area of water within 100 metres before the starting line. Two minutes before the defined starting time the competing boats have to take the lane determined in the programme"

In essence this means be at the start in good time, do not paddle too far away, stay within reach of the blue buoys (100 metre line), and get yourself lined up behind the correct lane. Poznan - Senior World Championships 2010

This year's World Championships was eagerly anticipated by the GB Team. After a successful start to the season and the great results at the senior Europeans our crews were eager to take on the Challenge of the 2010 Worlds.

Qualification for the Championships was again deliberately kept to what is now the normal high standard for GB crews who all expected to reach the finals. Even with these standards we had our largest ever World Championships team (38 people plus a further 7 in the Para Canoeing team). This gave GB the third largest team at the Championships some 45 people.

Travel to Poznan was not too difficult but the direct flights times only left us with one choice for the main team which was a very early flight out from Luton and an even earlier 6am flight back from Poznan. A few lucky people were able to catch the Ryan air flights which had better travel times but these did not work for the main team.

The organisation team at Poznan are used to running major competitions. Even so there was chaos at accreditation for the few days before competition. After that apart from a few small hitches with start gates the whole affair ran very smoothly.

Most of the team stayed in the park Hotel which is on the side of the regatta course but we did have a few support staff at another hotel in town. The Park Hotel is ideal as it's just 15 minute walk to the regatta course. The Para Canoe team stayed at the Hotel Polanez which is a short bus ride to the course. Breakfast and evening meals were at the hotels with lunch at the regatta course. Following the problems at Moscow we were cautious about the quality of midday meals at the course. This was unfounded as they were really quite good.

There has been a regatta course at Poznan for 20 years, the water is quite open and there can be a lot of chop from the banks as crews come down to the finish line. This year there was also a problem with weed on the course and some of our crews were unlucky enough to be affected with this problem. Conditions on the first day were really difficult with big waves and lots of chop making racing very difficult during the rest of the regatta the water conditions and weather were much better.

Results:

There were 75 Countries enrolled for the Championships a few had visa issues leave the final total at 72 Countries. We had entries 18 events plus a further 5 entries in the Para Canoe. The GB team performance was simply outstanding.

Tim looked really good in the K1 1000m laying down really good times which showed great promise for the finals. In the final it was just fantastic to watch him attack the race taking an early lead after about 50m he stretched his lead to more than a boat length which he held well into the last 200m.

There was a late challenge from the other boats which included the World Champion Max Hoff who after a great struggle just managed to pip Tim on the finish line. This was a great return to racing for Tim and was followed by another great performance in the 500m. He again reached the A final where he picked up weed on his rudder which almost certainly cost him a second medal.

Rachel Cawthorn has had a brilliant season and we had high hopes that she could repeat her K1 1000m Gold medal winning performance from the Senior Europeans. Rachel made the A final and after a tough race finish just outside the medals in 4th place. The K1 500m was at least on paper going to be even tougher race but Rachel again made the final with a great time 1.48.78. In the final Rachel was lying in fourth place at the half way mark and had to really attack the second half of the race. On the finish line she snatched the Bronze medal away from last year's silver medallist Katrina Wagner. This is GB's first ever Senior World Championship medal in our ladies team and simply fantastic result for Rachel and her coach Miklos. The future looks bright as we approach Olympic qualification next year.

In the Women's K2 races we had a young crew of Jenna Hawkey and Angela Hannah both racing at their first world championships. They were entered in both the K2 1000m and 500m events where we hoped they would gain some valuable experience. In the K2 1000m they had solid race in both the heat and semi final and qualified for the A final where they raced well finishing in 7th place. In the K2 500m they qualified for the B final and again finished 7th. A great first World's for the girls!

In the women's K4 500m we had a new crew (Abi, Hayleigh, Rachel and Louisa) which we hoped would be able to challenge for positions in the top half of the final. The girls finished second in both the heat and semi finals and qualified for the A final. In the final they were in the middle of the field on the first half of the race and pushed really hard for the finish. On the line it was incredibly close, the Hungarian crew took the gold and we finish in 5th place just 1/10th of a second off the medals. This puts us in a strong position with a young crew we can develop for 2012.

Sometimes results just don't look as good on paper as they really are. The Men's K4 crew had good races in the heats and the semi finals finishing 4th in each. They were never more than 2 seconds off the winning boat and easily broke the 3 minute barrier in both races in difficult choppy conditions. They needed a 3rd place or better to reach the (A) final and so had to race out the (B) final with some other very capable crews including last year's medal winning SVK K4. They finished 3rd in their final again just 2 seconds off the winning boat. A solid performance with potential for much more.

Jon Boyton and Ed Rutherford had a great World Championships. In the K2 1000m they were 3rd in their Semi final but just missed the fastest time that would put them in the a final. They went on to finish 3rd in the (B) final giving them a world ranking 12th. In the K2 500m they again just missed the (A) and then went on to win their B final. A great weekends work!

In the Canoe Class we had two boats at the World Championships. Matt Lawrence and James Train raced in the C2 1000m while Richard Jeffries raced his first world championships in the C1 200m.

Matt and James finished 4th in the heats and 5th in the semi finals with a best time of 3.45 seconds. This was enough to put them in the B final where they finished 6th. This was a disappointing result for Matt & James as it just equalled their 2005 world's championships C2 1000 time.

In the C1 200m Richard was putting in times in the .43 second area (probably 2 seconds off his best) which was quite good for the bumpy water conditions. He struggled to control his boat in the semi finals but still qualified for the C final. In the final he was leading the field when he capsized. Poznan is a difficult course at the best of times but Richard was really up for the race and I'm sure gained some valuable experience.

In the 200m events we had a really strong team racing in 6 events.

In the women's K1 Jess Walker was racing in the K1 200m for the first time. Jess had a good heat and semi final with solid times in the 41 second area. Jess just missed the (A) and then went on to win the (B) final. I'm sure with more race practice Jess will be able to challenge for medals next year. We also had a women's 200m relay team which won their heat putting them straight in the Final. Unfortunately the team just never got going in the final and finished a disappointing 6th.

In the Men's Kayaks 200m we had Ed Mckeever in the K1 and Jon and Liam in the K2. Both boats had won Gold at the Europeans and we hoped for more medals at the Worlds, we were not disappointed.

Ed Mckeever won his heat and semi getting faster with each run. In the final he took the lead after 20m and simply motored away winning by a massive .30 of a second (nearly a third of a boat length) the time a staggering .34.80 seconds (faster than many K2's)

Jon and Liam also had great races in the heats and semi finals. Again they went out and won both the early rounds against some very stiff opposition. In the final their time was .31.58 which gave them the Bronze medal just 3/100th of a second off Gold. These guys where then joined by Ed Cox and raced the men's relay. Two more great races saw them walking away with the Silver medal in the team event.

We had two boats in the 5k races. Tim had a good start but got caught up with other boats on the first round which left him chasing the lead group eventually finishing in 5th place. Lani Belcher also had a good race and was away with a lead group of three boats. On the last turn the BLR paddler hit Lani's boat breaking the rudder. This was unfortunate as Lani was looking very strong and would certainly have taken one of the medals.

We also had a small GBR Para Canoe Team at the Championships. I have included their results below and I'm sure that Trevor Wetherall will provide a short report on their experience.

I'm sure people will agree that this young team has enormous potential to qualify boats for the Olympic Games. They won 5 medals (4 in Olympic events) and have several other boats in contention for finals and medals.

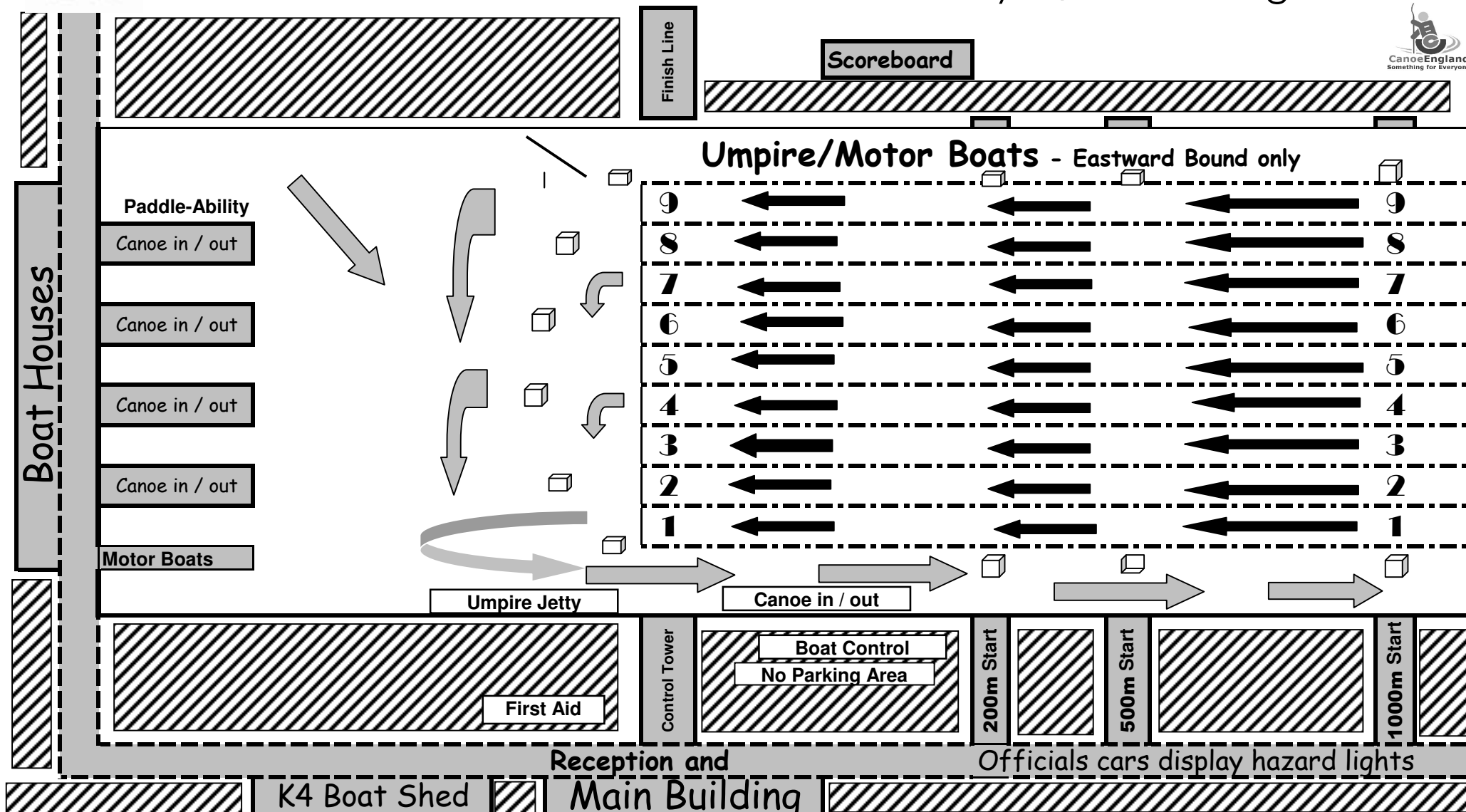

NWSC Course circulation pattern at BCU Regattas: All paddlers/athletes proceeding to the start must do on the Tower side **OUTSIDE THE BUOYED LANES**. Competitors warming up, or launching from pontoons on the main building side of the course, must not cross the racing lanes at any point nor must they attempt to delay proceedings by approaching the start on the course. **NO LAUNCHING** what so ever from the Umpire/Presentation jetty. the area between the finish line and the 10km turn buoys at the boathouse end of the course must be kept clear. All craft launching should proceed to the (Tower side) Westbound of the course around the outside of the 10km turn,
